The Watts family owns 300 acres at Zephyr Ridge in the Horse Heaven Hills and sources from other area growers. They have been growing grapes for 15 years.

Swiftwater Cellars has a 2500 case production with plans to increase to five to seven thousand cases in the future. Currently, the wines are produced at Artifex in Walla Walla, Washington; they will be made at the winery site beginning harvest 2010.
