Fruit de-stemmed and cold-soaked 5 days Native yeast fermentation; 1-2 punch downs per day 12 days skin to juice contact prior to pressing Minimal intervention - no added tannins, colors or enzymes Barrel-aged 10 months in new & used French oak (Francois Frères) Final blend: 87% Clone 115, 10% Clone 667, 3% Clone 777 Unfined and unfiltered Bottled August 2008

Location:	Just outside the town of Los Alamos in Cat Canyon, Santa Barbara AVA
Size:	77 acres; 35 acres Syrah
Planting:	South-facing slope on ancient sand dunes at 900 ft. elevation Planted in 1997 by Barry Henry of Chatsworth
Vineyard Information:	Sustainably farmed using primarily organic methods Sandy soil w/high drainage causing vine stress Syrah clone 1 on 5c rootstock; Syrah clone 6 on 140c Low yields under 2.5 tons per acre
Climate:	Cooling marine influences from Pacific Ocean Early morning fog and sunny afternoons
Winemaking:	27.2° Brix at harvest Fruit sorted and de-stemmed with 25% of berries crushed Six days “cold-soaking” Native yeast fermentation with submerged cap 18 days skin to juice contact prior to pressing Minimal intervention - no added tannins, colors or enzymes Barrel-aged 17 months in 100% new French oak (Ermitage) Bottled April 2009; unfinned and unfiltered
